Sporting Code

The championship will be run according to:

FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling CIAM General Rules Volume 2023 Edition.

FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling Volume F3 Radio Control Soaring Model Aircraft 2023 Edition.

FAI General Section and FAI Code of Ethics.

Anti-Doping Statement: if a competitor must take, for a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List, he must have a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) from the FAI.

FAI Sporting License: each competitor and Team Manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for the year of the championship. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database. The holder of a FAI Sporting License may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

Protest: any protest must be presented in writing to the Contest Director according to the FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, CIAM General rules C.20.

Composition of a national team

According to CIAM General Rules C.5. a national team consists of:

Maximum of 5 individual competitors, provided that at least one competitor is female and at least one is junior. A competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attains the age of 18

One Team Manager.

One assistant Team Manager.

Official helpers or timekeepers as permitted by the rules.

The reigning senior Champion Andreas Böhlen, Switzerland and junior Champion Roman Safonov, Russia has the right (subject to the approval of their NAC and the FAI) to participate in the championship. If they are not a member of the national team, their score or place will not be considered in the team results.

Classification and awards

Individual classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed juniors. If only one or two juniors compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

The best junior earns the title of Junior World or Continental Champion if juniors from at least four different nations participate.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed females. If only one or two females compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

The best female earns the title of Female World or Continental Champion if females from at least four different nations participate.

Team classification

FAI diplomas will be awarded to each member, including the fourth competitor and the Team Manager of the teams placed first, second and third.

FAI Trophies

Trophies wille be awarded to the World Champion and the best national team. Current holders are: F3B Individual Houlberg Trophy: Andreas Böhlen, Switzerland.

F3B Team Challenge Baron Mike Donne: Switzerland.

If the organizer does not receive enough entries by the deadline, the organizer may cancel the event, due to lack funding, or shorten the event.

Entry fees will not be accepted on arrival except exceptional circumstances and with the written agreement of the organizer.

A penalty of 10% will be applied to payments paid after the deadline.

Withdrawal

Should a team, or a member of a team, wish to withdraw from the championship, this must be done to the organizer in writing. The team, or team member, is entitled to a refund of the entry fee if the withdrawal is done before deadline of payment. Bank charges for the payment will be deducted from the refund.

Registration and processing

At registration the following documents and items are to be provided by the Team Manager:

Copy of banking payment receipts.

Two national flag (approx. 1 m x 1.5 m).

MP3 file with the national anthem.

A list of the team member's with FAI ID licences.

The following Items will be handed out to the Team Manager:

ID cards, starting numbers, meal and banquet tickets if ordered, tourist brochures etc.

Model Aircraft Specification Certificates

All models must be processed by the competitor's NAC in accordance with CIAM General Rules C.12. Model aircraft not properly processed by their NAC, with FAI certificates and stickers, will be processed by the organiser at a cost of 8 Euro for each model according to CIAM General Rules C.12 b.

Processing will be done from Friday till Sunday, detailed schedule will follow in a later bulletin. Bring one (1) completed Model Aircraft Specification Certificate per model to registered.

Insurance

Competitors need to be insured according to the rules of their nation. For the World Championship and pre-contest competitors will be covered by a third party liability insurance according to the FAI rules.

UAV regulations:

In Bulletin-2 we will provide all necessary information about applicable rules or requirements for UAVs regulations in place, which might affect the conduct of the event.

Medical care

The immediate medical First Aid to the participants is in the responsibility of the organizer during the official event. For emergencies, the next hospital is only 6,5 km away in Aabenraa. It is strongly recommended to all competitors that they have insurance which covers them for medical expenses and repatriation in the case of injury.

Frequencies

2.4 GHz standards for Denmark

100 mW eirp according to european standard ETSI EN 300 328 v.1.7.1 sub.22 with amendment of May 2008 minutes of the TCAM-26 conference. The transmitter must be CE marked and contestants must show the declaration of conformity if asked by the organization.

Arrival by air plane

Nearest airports are Billund in Denmark, 100 km. from venue, Hamburg in Germany, 190 km. from venue and Copenhagen in Denmark, 290 km. from venue.

Power supply

Current is 230 Volts at 50Hz, plugs as shown.



Facilities

We will provide a tent with a space of approximately 6×3 meters and a table with benches for the teams who wants. In the tent 230 Volt is supplied for charging, cooling boxes, water heaters, light etc. Ordering will be in the official registration.

Catering

Catering will be provided on site. At least lunch will be provided, but we will try to provide breakfast and evening dinner too. Cost and availability will be anounced at latest in the official registration.
